Juror's Statement Laurin McCracken AWS, NWS, LWS

Judging an art show is, for me, a multi-stage process. The first look at all the submissions gave me a general overview of the quality of the submissions and sets out the road ahead. When I looked at this year's submissions to your show, I was reminded of how much delight there is in seeing good art. The second look through of the submissions gave me a sense of how difficult it will be to narrow the selection down to the prescribed number set by your committee. With this "look though" I was struck by the joy and happiness represented in the paintings submitted.

I was also delighted by the number of artists with national reputations that had once again submitted for your show. It is a reminder that the Louisiana Watercolor Society's International Exhibition is considered by noted artists as being an important show.

As I started narrowing the field and looking for the best paintings for inclusion in the show, I was making my choices based on a number of criteria; composition, sense of color, and basic drawing skills, such as an understanding of perspective. I was always looking for the quality of the craft of watercolor painting.

My final choices were almost all driven by one thought "I wish I had painted that". And there were many of those. The final cut was not an easy one to make. As in every show, not all of the good paintings can be included. I encourage all who submitted to keep painting and keep submitting. I hope your audience will enjoy those I have selected as the best from those submitted.

I hope that you will agree with me as you view these fine paintings that there is a joy of painting represented in every one of them. These paintings represent a very high level of craftsmanship in watercolor painting. Many of these paintings were difficult to produce and took a lot of work on the part of the artist that produced them. However, they were all produced because the artists had a love of painting and produced these paintings with a smile in their hearts.

The inspiration for this piece came the second I saw it! The light, the colors, the composition all came together like the planets lining up!


