2 Day Workshop: Incorporating Gold into Watercolor Paintings

Taught by Kathy Miller Stone LWS-M **Date:** June 20-21 at David Art Center **Fees:** \$175 Members (\$225 Non-members).

Kathy is an award winning artist who has earned signatures in several watercolor societies including NWS and a Master Signature in the Louisiana Watercolor Society. Her paintings have been published in *Watercolor Magazine*, *Best of Watercolor: Painting Light and Shadow, Splash 8*, *Confident Color* by Nita Leland and *The Artistic Touch 4* & 5 by Chris Unwin.

Kathy will share techniques for painting a gold subject with watercolor. She enjoys passing along "Tips of the Trade" and will demo some products like gold gesso and gold watercolor paint. Students will each receive a small 1 oz. sample size of the gold gesso to try out, included as part of the tuition. Students can bring older paintings to embellish or create new designs. Exhibit Rules:

Paintings must be new to our member show *and* never shown before at the Archives.

2018 dues must be paid to participate in member shows. Original watercolors on paper, neutral mats and wired frames.

Since the Archives is a State building, all art must be suitable for viewing by people of all ages (no nudes).

Entering this show means that you agree to all the guidelines established by LWS.

Workshop paintings, including copies repainted after the workshop, are not allowed.
