The reception will follow on Saturday, March 5 from 2pm to 4pm. If you are entering the Spring Member Show, please remember that the same rules apply to this exhibit as apply to any national show. Reference photos must be your own and if there is a dispute, you may be asked to produce them. You may not use any other artist's image, such as prints, giclees or online print house merchandise as your reference. No workshop paintings or reproductions of workshop paintings are allowed.

In May, we are extremely pleased to host Paul Jackson as our International Show juror and judge. His popular workshop will be held Wednesday, May 4 - Friday, May 6 at David Art Center, 3020 N. Arnoult Rd., Metairie, LA. Please see the website for particulars. There is a waiting list! After the workshop, LWS will host our 46th International Exhibition at Place St. Charles from May 7 - May 20, 2016.

My favorite part of our International Exhibition is seeing the juried paintings in person. Exhibit Rules:

Paintings must be new to our member show *and* never shown before at the Archives.

2016 dues must be paid to participate in member shows. Original watercolors on paper, neutral mats and wired frames.

Since the Archives is a State building, all art must be suitable for viewing by people of all ages (no nudes).

Declaration of Originality:

I certify by my signature below and submission of my painting to this Exhibit/Show that each painting submitted by me is an original composition, executed by me without the help of a teacher, is not a class project or exercise, and has not been copied or in any way created by me based on the work of another artist in any medium, including but not limited to the use of any photograph without permission of the photographer. Copies of workshop paintings repainted outside of the workshop are ineligible. If requested, I will provide all-reference materials and/or sketches that trace the creation of this composition to establish that it is my original work. I have read the guidelines for exhibits and agree that any violation of this declaration will disqualify my painting from eligibility for this Exhibit/Show, and I will abide by the decision of the LWS Board in connection with any determination regarding such eligibility.
